**Entries Close:-** 11<sup>th</sup> July 2010.

**DIRECTIONS:** From the M40 North or South come off at junction 9. Follow signs towards Bicester then pick up the A4421 towards Buckingham. Follow A4421 out of Bicester. After approx 6 miles go past a SP saying Newton Purcell. Approx 10 – 15 yds after this sign there is a left hand turning down a farm track marked "Home Farm". (There will also be orange HVS signs). Follow **LONG** track down past house and over cattle grid where you will turn immediately left into the field and reception area.

**Raffle:** There will be a raffle on the day. Any unwanted old Christmas presents from long lost Aunts or donations will be gratefully received!

**Please bring 2 canvas dummies with you on the day. Open tests may include cold game.**
