If entries are oversubscribed a ballot will take place giving preference to HVS Members and after that, HV Members with Adult Dogs. Notification of receiving an offer of a run will be sent out within 48hrs after the closing date.

Please Note: This pre-Selection Assessment is only open to Hungarian Vizsla and Hungarian Wirehaired Vizsla. This is <u>NOT</u> a Spring Pointing Test and with that in mind, there will be no awards given. This is a pre-Selection Assessment event where suitable dogs will be invited to the Final Team GB Selection Day. Handlers will be required to fire a starting pistol upon flushed game off point.

JUNIOR: For dogs over 6 months of age and under **3** years of age as of 7th September 2024.

ADULT: For dogs over **3** years of age as of 7th September 2024.



Assessed Criteria:

<u>Hunting</u>

- Each dog will be run singly and wherever possible, into wind for 10 minutes (except when regarded as out of control)
- The dog will be afforded a single settling in minute at the start of its run where credits are noted but faults ignored (except being out of control)
- The run will last a minimum of 10 minutes excepting where eliminated
- Dogs will not be recalled for a second run unless their first run was Excellent and there was no opportunity to point game
- The dog should acknowledge and be steady to all game
- The dog will be assessed (but not limited to) for its:
 - o Ground treatment
 - o Pattern
 - Covering sufficient ground without or with limited intervention of the whistle
 - Use of wind without back casting
 - o Game finding ability
 - o Drive and purpose to hunt without or with limited intervention of the whistle
 - Pace and style Including correct head carriage

Pointing

- The dog must positively locate and point its quarry
- The dog should not persistently false point
- The dog should hold point until the handler commands to flush on the direction of the Assessors
- The dog should not be sticky on point
- The dog should be steady to the flush and shot
 - o Handlers are expected to fire a shot from a starting pistol upon flush
- Failure to point and/or missing game on its ground is regarded as a fault
