1ST Kozel Nyers Umbra (Mrs J Ryman). Very well made puppy who was not at all fazed by his surroundings. Lovely head shape with good width between the ears and skull longer than muzzle. Clean neck. Very good lay of shoulder and equal length of upper arm. Correct depth of chest and spring of rib for age. Well made hindquarters. Excellent bone and feet. Moved with confidence. Best Baby Puppy.

Baby Puppy Bitch

1ST Nordicfield Lady Jaeger (Mrs R Warner). Very elegant bitch. Well balanced all through. Scores in head and expression. Clean neck leading to well laid shoulders and upper arm of equal length. Correct depth of chest and length of rib cage. Well made hindquarters. Standing over at the knee at the moment but this will change as she grows. Moved out on a good stride.

Minor Puppy Dog

Entries: 4 Absentees: 0

1ST Listerlo Amber Management (Mrs K Petitclerc). Well balanced all through. Head of good proportions with low set ears. Clean neck. Very good forehand assembly. Enough depth of chest for age with good length of ribcage and slight tuck up. Well made hindquarters with correct angulation and well placed hocks. Excellent bone and feet. Coat of good texture. Moved well on a good stride.

2ND Hanalei Suns Out Guns Out for Alaszdale (Miss H & Mr D & Mrs M Senior & Brett-Williams & Porfido De Lucia). Good overall balance. Well shaped head with correct stop and breadth of skull. Clean neck leading to good shoulder placement. Not holding his topline as well as the winner. Good strength in hindquarters. Correct amount of bone with very good feet. Moved out well but carried tail too high.

3RD Lindenwood Cast A Spell at Madarkutya (Mrs D L Carter)

2ND Lindenwood Cast A Spell at Madarkutya (Mrs D L Carter). Good overall balance. Head of good shape and proportions. Clean neck. Not quite the layback of shoulder as the winner nor the length in ribcage. Well made hindquarters with moderate angulation. Good bone and feet. Little close behind moving away.

Junior Dog

Entries: 3 Absentees: 0

1ST Glengamna Malbec (Mr M P Woodcock). Well balanced all through. Clean head of correct proportions and low set ears. Strong neck leading to well laid shoulder and corresponding length of upper arm. Correct depth of chest. Well sprung ribcage with moderate tuck up. Scores in hindquarters with correctly turned stifles and good definition of second thigh. Excellent bone and feet. Coat of good texture. Moved out well with good forward reach and correct tail carriage.

2ND Ivyvizbridge Gertor (Mrs Em & Mr Ge Dallas). Not quite as together as the winner. Balanced head with skull slightly longer than muzzle. Little upright in shoulder and not quite enough depth in chest. Well sprung ribcage. Correctly shaped hindquarters with moderate bend of stifle. Good bone. Feet would look a lot better if the nails were a lot shorter. Moved steadily.

3RD Ivyvizbridge Wackator (Ms E J Milner)

1ST Roughshoot Seabiscuit at Parmelly JW (Mr S & Mrs K Palmer). Impressive youngster who gave a very good account of himself. Excellent overall balance. Head well proportioned, lean with moderate stop and low set ears. Clean neck of good length leading to well laid shoulder. Correct depth of chest and spring of ribcage. Scores in hindquarters which are strong and well muscled with correct angulation. Quality bone and excellent cat like feet with short dark nails. Coat of good texture. Moved out well with correct forward reach and rear drive.

2ND Glengamna Malbec (Mr M P Woodcock) 2nd JD.

3RD Szelkiraly's Foolproof JW (Miss C & Mr W Murray & Parker)

Novice Dog

Entries: 2 Absentees: 0

1ST Vizslanya Pelion (Mrs Em & Mr Ge Dallas). Taller than my ideal but well balanced all through. Balanced head with moderate stop. Clean neck. Would like more layback of shoulder. Good depth of chest. Would like a little more length of ribcage. Scores in hindquarters with good width of second thigh and well placed hocks. Moved soundly.

2ND Kensesqui Creepy Ghost (Mr A Havers). Smaller than the winner but within the standard and well balanced all through. Balanced head – I would prefer slightly less stop. Clean neck. Reasonable lay of shoulder. Good length of ribcage. Little straight in stifle. Correct amount of bone. Moved steadily.

Post Graduate Dog

Entries: 9 Absentees: 0

1ST Roughshoot Red Wine of Solencia (Mr M & Mr B Rackett). Well made with good overall balance. Nicely proportioned head with moderate stop and correct breadth of skull. Clean neck leading to well placed shoulders and equal length of upper arm. Good depth of chest. Well ribbed back with moderate tuck up. Strong, well muscled hindquarters with hocks squarely placed. Excellent bone and feet. Moved with drive.

2ND Perllanside Street Party JW (Miss J Wall). Well balanced all through. Scores in head with moderate stop and correct median line. Clean neck leading to well laid shoulder. I would like a little more length of upper arm. Good depth of chest and length of ribcage. Well muscled hindquarters. Excellent bone and feet. Coat of good texture. Moved soundly on a good stride.

3RD Wallaroo Beyond The Horizon at Redhunt (Mr P & Mrs S Mcbeath)

Limit Dog

1ST Bournehouse Romeo (Mr R & Miss C Williams & Gillard). I was very impressed with this dog. Excellent overall balance. Lean head with moderate stop and median line down the forehead. Strong neck leading to well laid shoulders and corresponding length of upper arm. Correct depth of chest and length of ribcage showing slight tuck up. Strong hindquarters with correct turn of stifle. Excellent bone and tight round feet with short dark nails. Coat of excellent texture. Moved very fluidly at one with his handler demonstrating good forward reach. His handler got the very best out of him at all times. Well deserved RCC.

2ND Roughshoot Heaven Sent of Solencia JW (Mr M & Mr B & Miss L Rackett & Rackett & Wilcox). Another quality dog who presents a very good outline when stacked. Good head shape with skull slightly longer than muzzle and low set ears. Clean neck. Scores in his forehead construction with shoulders well laid back and corresponding length and return of upper arm. Well sprung ribcage. Strong well muscled hindquarters with good width of second thigh. Excellent bone and feet. Moved with great drive – just preferred the tail carriage of the winner but a lovely dog none the less who again was presented and handled to advantage.

3RD Pitswarren Tempus Viator (ai) JW (Mr J P & Mrs E J Harper)

Open Dog

1ST Nemzet Kincse Ipa of Alazsdale (Imp Hun) (Miss H Senior). Well balanced all through. Head of good dimensions with moderate stop and low set ears. Clean neck leading to good lay of shoulder. I would like a little more length in upper arm. Good depth of chest. Excellent length and spring of ribcage with moderate tuck up. Scores in hindquarters with correctly turned stifles and good width of second thigh. Quality bone and the best of feet. Coat of very good texture. Moved out well on a good stride.

2ND Debian Deerhunter JW (Miss D Warnes). Good overall balance. Head lean and of correct proportions. Clean neck leading to well laid shoulder. Again I would like a little more

length in upper arm. Good depth of chest. I would like a little more length to his ribcage. Very well made hindquarters with well turned stifles. Good bone. Another whose feet would have benefitted from the nails being cut back. Moved soundly.

3RD Ambravittoriya Oskar at Listerlo (Imp Rus) (Mrs E Hughes)

Champion Dog

1ST Sh Ch Kincsem Break Every Rule JW (Ms T & Mrs S Watkins & Kain). Superb dog from any angle. He is beautifully balanced and hard to fault. His head is lean with a noble appearance. Correct median line down the forehead, moderate stop and low set ears. Strong moderately arched neck leading to well laid back shoulders and length and return of upper arm. Chest of good depth with elbows close to the body. Good length and spring of ribcage. Strong, well muscled hindquarters with correct turn of stifle. Quality bone and the best of feet. On the move he is accurate both fore and aft showing good open side gait when viewed in profile. I had no hesitation in awarding him the DCC and ultimately Best in Show.

1ST Facanvadasz Csongor of Mullerthal (Mrs D Morse). Good overall balance. Head of correct dimensions with moderate stop and low set ears. Neck is clean – I would like a little more strength to it. Well laid shoulder and corresponding return of upper arm. Good depth of chest and length of ribcage. Well made hindquarters with good turn of stifle. Quality bone and good round feet. Moved out well on a good stride.

Veteran Dog

Entries: 2 Absentees: 0

1ST Highforce Future Legend for Vizslanya JW ShCEX VW (Mr S & Mrs K M Challis). Strongly made dog who is well balanced all through. Head is well proportioned – ears could be set a little lower. Strong, slightly arched neck leading to well laid shoulder and corresponding return of upper arm. Good depth of chest with elbows close to the body. Correct length and spring of ribcage. Powerful hindquarters with good turn of stifle. Excellent bone and feet. Moved out well on a good stride.

2ND Gunfield Phantom (Ms M Kiely). Good overall balance. Lean head of good proportions with moderate stop and low set ears. Strong neck leading to well laid shoulder and equal length of upper arm. Good depth of chest with elbows close to the body. Well sprung ribcage. Carrying a little overweight. Well made hindquarters with correct turn of stifle. Coat of good texture. Not quite as free in movement as the winner

Minor Puppy Bitch

1ST Glenbrows Blush at Tantaraviz (Miss C M & Mr T D & Mrs H L Ward & Harrison & Harrison). Absolutely super puppy. So well balanced and true to type. Excellent overall balance. Lean lead with moderate stop and well placed ears. Clean slightly arched neck leading to well laid shoulder and corresponding return of upper arm. Correct depth of chest and length of ribcage. Strong hindquarters with moderate turn of stifle and well placed hocks. Moved out well on a good stride. Handled beautifully to advantage. Best Puppy In Show.

2ND Glenbrows Scarlet (Miss V & Mr T D & Mrs H L Parker & Harrison & Harrison). Litter sister to the winner and very similar. I am sure they will change places often as there is not much between them. At the moment the winner is slightly more developed in her chest and ribcage which gave her the edge. This bitch has a lovely head with slight stop and correct median line. Clean neck leading to well laid shoulders and equal length of upper arm. Good length of ribcage with slight tuck up. Scores in hindquarters with excellent bone and feet. Another that was handled to advantage. Moved out well.

3RD Lindenwood Blessed Be (Miss C M Anstee)

Puppy Bitch

1ST Solencia Misty Morning (Mr B & Mr M Rackett). Another quality puppy whom I am sure we will hear a lot more of in the future. Beautifully balanced all through. Scores in head which is lean and correctly proportioned. Strong slightly arched neck leading to well laid shoulder and return of upper arm. Good depth of chest. Could have a fraction more length to her ribcage. Strong hindquarters with well turned stifles and correctly placed hocks. Quality bone and the best of feet. Well handled to maximise her many attributes. Moved out well showing good forward reach.

2ND Glenbrows Scarlet (Miss V & Mr T D & Mrs H L Parker & Harrison & Harrison) 2nd MPB

Junior Bitch

Entries: 6 Absentees: 0

1ST Nevedith Golden Reign at Szelfuto JW (Mrs D & Mrs E Hardy & Phillips). I absolutely loved this bitch. She is so well balanced and presents an excellent outline when viewed in profile. Her head is lean with a moderate stop and correct median line. Skull slightly longer than the muzzle and ears correctly set. Strong neck leading to well laid shoulder and corresponding length and return of upper arm. Chest of good depth with elbows close to the body. Ribcage well sprung and carried well back. Scores in hindquarters which are well muscled with correctly turned stifles. Quality bone and feet. Movement was effortless with her handler getting the best out of her. Easy winner of this class and pushed hard all the way for top honours. Just lacked the maturity of the eventual CC winner but very well deserved RCC.

2ND Oroshaza Blanka (Mrs D & Mrs C Clubb & Mason). Good overall balance. Head is well proportioned with slight stop and skull longer than the muzzle. Strong slightly arched neck. Not quite the forehead construction as that of the winner. Excellent depth of chest

and well ribbed back. Well made hindquarters with correct turn of stifle. Moved out soundly.

3RD Glenbrows Opera D'arte JW (Ms C Gammon)

Yearling Bitch

Entries: 5 Absentees: 2

1ST Szelkiry's Lovefool (Miss C & Mr W Murray & Parker). Well balanced all through. Head lean and of correct proportions. Strong slightly arched neck leading to well laid shoulder. A little short in upper arm. Good depth of chest and spring of rib. Moderate tuck up. Well made hindquarters with quality bone and good feet. Coat of good texture. Moved out on a good stride.

2ND Nicael Christmas Holly (Mrs A & Mr J Cox). Good overall balance. Head lean with skull slightly longer than muzzle. Strong slightly arched neck leading to well laid shoulder and corresponding length of upper arm. Good depth of chest and length of ribcage. Well made hindquarters. Excellent bone and feet. Tended to fly her tail on the move. Very good coat texture.

3RD Martgarian Zantara JW (Ms C Gammon)

Novice Bitch

Entries: 4 Absentees: 2

1ST Fairwayview Red Squirrel (Mrs E Henderson). Good overall balance. Pleasing head with skull longer than muzzle. Lips could be neater. Strong, slightly arched neck into well laid shoulder. A little short in upper arm. Good depth of chest and length of ribcage. Well made hindquarters with moderate bend of stifle. Excellent bone and neat feet. Moved soundly – little untidy coming towards.

2ND Aranyvadasz Uccu for Kinharrachie (Imp Hun) NAF TAF (Ms Al Stalker). Well balanced all through. Head lean and of good shape. Slightly arched neck. A little upright in shoulder and I would like a little more depth of chest. Good length of ribcage with slight tuck up. Well made hindquarters with moderate turn of stifle. Moved steadily.

Post Graduate Bitch

Entries: 12 Absentees: 1

1ST Perlanside Fly The Flag (Miss J Wall). Smart bitch who presents good outline. Lean head with slight stop and skull slightly longer than muzzle. Strong neck leading to very good lay of shoulder and corresponding return of upper arm. Good depth of chest with elbows close to the body. Well sprung ribcage of good length with moderate tuck up. Scores in hindquarters with well turned stifles and good width of second thigh. Excellent bone and feet. Coat of good texture. Moved out well with good open side gait.

2ND Parcroft Destiny for Aranyszív (Mrs G & Mr D Curzon-Price). Another quality bitch who presents a typical outline. Head is lean with correct median line and moderate stop. Neck of good length and slightly arched leading to well laid shoulders. Chest of good depth. Excellent length and spring of ribcage. Hindquarters are well made with correct turn of stifle. Excellent bone. Feet slightly marred by nails that were a little too long. Moved out well on a good stride.

3RD Kenzduo Atina (Miss M Wiblin)

Limit Bitch

Entries: 14 Absentees: 2

1ST Glenbrows Rouge JW (Miss V & Mr J Parker & Gist). Headed a strong class of bitches. Excellent overall balance presenting lovely outline. Lean head with moderate stop and correct median line. Strong, slightly arched neck leading to very good lay of shoulder and corresponding return of upper arm. Chest is of good depth with elbows close to the body. Good length and spring of rib. Scores in hindquarters with correctly bent stifles and good width of second thigh. Excellent bone and the best of feet. Moved freely on a good stride.

2ND Glenbrows Roulette at Danton (Mr A & Mr B & Ms C Scourfield & Kantor & Ward). Litter sister to the winner and many of the same attributes apply. There really wasn't very much between them. Lovely lean head with moderate stop and low set ears. Strong slightly arched neck with well laid shoulder and return of upper arm. Good depth of chest and length of ribcage. Strong hindquarters with correct bend of stifle. Quality bone and good feet. Moved well on a good stride. Very close call between the first and second. I just slightly preferred the overall outline of the winner.

3RD Vizash Heiress of Caorunn JW (Miss G Aynsley)

Open Bitch

Entries: 5 Absentees: 2

1ST Nordicfield Dawn Run (Mrs R Warner). Good overall balance and free from exaggeration. Lean head with well set ears. Slightly arched neck of good length leading to well laid shoulders. Elbows could be a little closer to the body. Good length of ribcage with slight tuck up. Strong hindquarters with good width of second thigh. Good bone and feet. Moved out well on a good stride.

2ND Ambravittoriya Art of Love for Marghele (Imp Rus) JW (Miss K G Bradley). Well balanced all through. Head of good proportions with moderate stop and low set ears. Clean neck leading to well laid shoulder. I would like a little more length to the upper arm. Good length and spring of rib. Strong hindquarters with good width of second thigh. Excellent bone and feet. Moved soundly.

3RD Oroshaza Lucy Locket (Mrs D & Mrs C Clubb & Mason)

Champion Bitch

Entries: 3 Absentees: 1

1ST Sh Ch Danton Obsession with Tantaraviz ShCEX (Miss C M Ward). Not a bitch I have judged before but I thought she was absolutely stunning. She is beautifully balanced and presents a very typical outline when viewed in profile. Her head has the look of aristocracy – lean and noble with a moderate stop, correct median line and well set ears of a good length. Neck is strong and slightly arched leading to exemplary forehead construction. Chest of good depth with elbows placed close to the body. Excellent length and spring of ribcage. Scores in hindquarters with correctly bent stifles and good width of second thigh. Well placed hocks with parallel rear pasterns. Quality bone and cat like feet. On the move she is effortless – accurate fore and aft and showing good drive when viewed in profile. Her handler got the very best out of her – they were totally at one together and a pleasure to watch. It was a privilege to judge her today and she was a worthy winner of the BCC.

2ND Sh Ch Pitswarren Jiko JW (Mrs E J Harper). Good overall balance. Head nicely proportioned with moderate stop and low set ears. Neck strong and slightly arched. Scores in forehand construction. Good depth of chest with elbows close to the body. Ribcage well sprung and of good length. I would prefer a little less angulation in hindquarters. Good bone. Coat of good texture. Moved out on a good stride.

Field Trial Bitch

1ST Ch Piroseg Mandarin of Perllanside JW (Miss J Wall). They say that this is the easiest class to win – so it may be but it is the hardest one to qualify for!!! And what a lovely bitch as well. Beauty as well as brains and very hard to believe she is over 9 years old. A great credit to her owner. Excellent overall balance. Lean head with moderate stop and correct ear set. Strong slightly arched neck leading to well laid shoulder and corresponding length of upper arm. Good depth of chest with elbows close to the body. Excellent length and spring of rib. Strong, well muscled hindquarters with good width of second thigh. Quality bone and strong, cat like feet. Moved out really well with good tail action.

Special Working Bitch

2ND Sheepcothill Lilo (Miss C M Anstee). Slightly squarer in outline than would be my preference. Well proportioned head with low set ears. Little upright in shoulder and out at elbow. Good length of ribcage with moderate tuck up. Strong hindquarters. Good bone. Another whose nails need cutting back.

Veteran Bitch

1ST Sh Ch Vizslanya Sziena JW ShCEx OSW (Mr D J & Ms E M Hardcastle & Bradley). One of my favourite girls and it was a pleasure to judge her again today. Well balanced all through. Lean head with correct median line and moderate stop. Strong, slightly arched neck. Scores in forehand construction. Chest of good depth with elbows close to the body. Good length of ribcage with moderate tuck up. Strong hindquarters with hocks well placed. Moved out freely at one with her handler. BVIS.

2ND Sh Ch Recuerdo Monika of Caorunn (Miss G Aynsley). Another worthy champion not showing her age in any way. Lovely head of noble appearance. Strong neck. Not quite the forehand construction as that of the winner. Good depth of chest and length of ribcage. Scores in hindquarters. Quality bone and good feet. Moved out soundly.

3RD Lutra Nordic Run at Nordicfield (Mrs R Warner)
