**Stakes**    **Approx. Time** (exact time to be confirmed after any ballots have been drawn; will be subject to entry numbers)\*\*

**Puppy and Novice Dog Novice Handler (NDNH)**    **8.45 am for 9 am start**

*Puppy:* aged between 6 and 18 months on the day of test

*NDNH:* confined to dog and handler who have not gained any award in a field trial or classified GWT or won a NDNH test

**Novice**    **11.15 am for 11.30 am start**

For dogs which have not been placed 1<sup>st</sup> in a Novice GWT, or 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> in an Open GWT, or gained an award or Certificate of Merit at a Field Trial

**Open**    **2.15 pm for 2.30 pm start**

**Entries**    £15 HVS Members; £20 Non-members

Entries will be limited to approx. 25 per stake (subject to entry numbers); and only **ONE** entry per handler in Novice. Priority will be given to HVS Members; where oversubscribed a ballot will be held. Payment will be required within 48 hrs of the ballot.
