My two concerns for our lovely breed are eye shape which should not be round and also heads which seem to be getting too heavy with hanging flews and these dogs would struggle holding game which is what they are bred for

MPD(4) 1. Whitfields Russetmantle Teak Von Alfizsbet, Lots to like about this 7 month old boy who was not overdone in any way for his age. Super head with correct proportions, kind eye of good shape. Enough Heart room and good spring of rib. Stood on lovely feet and moved very together for his age. Pleased to award him Best Puppy in Show

2. Husseys Debian Dirty Harry, another 7 month old boy with a nice head and earset. Not quite the loin as 1 but had good bone and depth with correct tail set and moved out well

3. Kiely Debian Dionysus for Ruamadra

PD(3) 1. Husseys Debian Dirty Harry 2. Kiely Debian Dionysus For Ruamadra, litter brother to 1 with lots to like . Very balanced youngster with a nice outline, sound & true on the move. Straight front developing well but just preferred head of 1 3. Rymans Kozel Nyers Umbra

JD(5)(2) 1. Carter Lindenwood Cast a Spell at Madarkutya, Loved this boys head which is so breed type and a lovely kind eye. He is still a bit raw at 12 months but everything is there. Good shoulder and upper arm which allowed him to move out with precision and he had a strong topline. 2. Petitclerc Listerlo Amber Management, Another who is only just out of puppy but a very balanced boy who moved out well. Nice head with a Kind expression. Clean neck into a good lay of shoulder. Well off for bone and decent feet 3. Senior, Brett-Williams & Porfido De Lucia Hanalei Suns Out Guns Out for Alaszdale

YD(1) 1. Woodcocks Glengamna Malbec JW, have admired this young boy since he was a pup and he did not disappoint me when I got my hands on him. Slightly darker in colour but has a lovely dark almond shape eye to match Head of good proportions and wide nostrils. Good depth to brisket and chest. He moved with good extension and drive RCC

ND(3) 1. Petitclerc Listerlo Amber Management 2. Smith & Walkers Butterfly Hunter Cosmopoliton, 12 month old dog with a nice head and a strong neck . Decent shoulder but not the return of upper arm as 1. He moved well covering ground but preferred topline if 1 also

3. Rymans Kozel Nyers Umbra

PGD(5) 1. Littlers Apolwoodwin Moonshine, 2 year old dog with a lovely head and soft expression. Good reach of neck into a good lay of shoulder . Moderate angulation all through and feel he has more maturing to do to finish 2. Senior Oakswarren /Feel the Heat

At Alazsdale, lovely outline on this dog with good depth throughout, clean neck of good length. Moved well but preferred head of winner. 3. Walls Perllanside Street Party JW LD (5)(1) 1. Harpers Pitswarren Tempus Viator(AI) JW, Commanding young dog who looked a picture on the stack and balanced all through. Masculine head not overdone with moderate stop. Strong muscular neck. Good depth to brisket with prominent forechest. Well

Ribbed back and he moved soundly and light footed CC & pleased to award him Best In Show 2. Hughes Listerlo Mr Magoo. Noble looking head on this boy. Liked the flow from neck to his topline. Would like a bit more depth in brisket but still has time on his side

Correct tail set and he covered the ground well on the move 3. Challis Vizlanya Domenkos JW

OD (3) 1. Senior Nemzet Ipa of Alazsdale, Robust looking dog with good bone, masculine head and a kind eye and nice expression. Plenty of depth and heart room. Moderate angulation and moved out well with drive 2. Hughes Ambravittoriya Oskar at Listerlo(ImpRus) A well

balanced dog with a lovely head well chiselled & a toning eye. Good clean reach of neck into a strong topline . Well ribbed back. On the move he showed good coordination and handled well to get the best out of him

CHD(2) 1.Challis SH.CH. Vizslanya Aragonia JWShCExOSVW, Done well for this boy before and he is still looking good for 7. Super head with a lovely dark almond eye. He is moderate throughout with a good ribcage and depth to brisket. Hocks well let down and he is

Light footed on the move but he is beginning to drop his topline slightly. 2. Da Silva & Sexton SH.CH. Amarantos Katina for Ertekes JW, eye catching boy on the stack with good bone. Neck of good length into a strong topline. Straight front and neat feet. His rear angulation

Is not overdone and he moved out well but would like a bit more work in his head

FTD(2)(1) Carters Facanvadasz Andris, Good honest 6 year old dog who certainly looks like he could work all day. Liked his head and kind expression. His angles are well matched both front and rear. His movement was on an easy covering the ground stride and his hindquarters

Strong and well muscled.

VD(3)(1) 1. Challis Hlghforce Future Legend for Vizslanya JW SHCex.VW, Strong looking boy who at 9 years is looking good. Nice head and ear set, straight front with good depth throughout. He moved with purpose but another who was light on his feet. For me though he's a bit

dark in colour 2. Clubb & Mason SH.CH. Oroshaza Chukar VW CW18, Another fit looking boy of 10 years. Stands up well on strong pasterns and straight front. Kind expression in this boys eyes and good ear set . Well ribbed back. Moved well for his age but would like a bit more

Length to him

MPB(8)(1) 1. Gottlieb Russetmantle Taffeta, delightful 7 month old puppy. She has a lovely head complemented by a soft appealing expression and a correct almond shape

eye. Clean reach of neck into a good shoulder placement. Stands on neat catlike feet and her front is straight

and true. Her movement was very together for a minor puppy. 2. Mills Nemzet Kincse Jaffa at Karrouki, another lovely put together puppy with a mischievous expression. Ample depth for a minor puppy and another with good neat feet. Well boned and again moved very together on a nice

easy stride 3. Warnes Debian Definitely Maybe

PB(5) 1. Smith & Walker Butterfly Hunter Pancake, Liked this 9 month puppy bitch for her overall balance. Super head showing good proportions and eye shape, depth to brisket already and has a elegant neck into a well placed shoulder, good spring of rib and correct tail set. Really liked her hindquarters which she used well when moving but please tend to her nails as need to be shorter Best Puppy Bitch 2. McDonalds Donurie's Harlekuin, lovely type with a lot to like. Only 6 months so giving away 3 months to class winner. Feminine head with correct ear set. Kind eye and expression

Strong arched neck into a good shoulder. Moderate angulation at the rear which enabled her to move with good extension. Handled very well 3. Mills Nemzet Kincse Jaffa

JB(5)(1) 1. Priestleys Eltrym Shooting Star, Mature looking girl for 13 months with a nice alert expression. Deep in body and brisket. Strong over the loin and hindquarters.

Moved well on a nice easy stride but nails could be shorter 2. Steedens Lindenwood Witchcraft, finer built girl but just out of puppy. Feminine head with lovely eye shape and colour. Clean neck into a good shoulder placement. Straight front and has enough depth for her age. Strong loin and correct tail set and stands on lovely feet with short nails. 3. Ward & Harrison Glenbrows Blush at Tantaraviz

YB(6)(1) Winkworth & Woodcock Silvestre Fit as a Fiddle. Such a well balanced and sound moving girl. Loved her feminine head and expression. Moderate angulation both fore and aft. Correct croup and tail set. When moving she floated round the ring. More to come from this girl im sure. Pleased to award her the CC & RBIS 2. Hardy & Phillips Nevedith Golden Reign at Szelfuto JW, Pleasing head with good eye shape. Strong neck and a well filled fore chest. Shorter coupled than 1 but still balanced on the move. Strong rear quarters which powered her around the ring

3. Gammons Glenbrows Opera D'Arte JW

NB(6)(2) 1. Swallow Facanvadasz Csilar of Csilogo, 4 year old girl who is up to size but has good proportions throughout. She has a lovely inquisitive expression and her ears really frame her face. Straight front and nice feet. She moved well and because she has length to her looked

Balanced and kept her topline both standing and moving. 2. Connollys Roughshoot Tiffin. 2 year old girl with a pleasing head. Clean strong neck with a nice flow into a good shoulder. Straight front with enough infill. Ribs well sprung. Moved OK 3. Ward & Harrison Glenbrows

PGB(11) 1. Warnes Nordicfield Desert Gold, Well constructed 4 year old girl who is quite eye catching. She has a balanced head shape and gentle almond eye. Well off for bone but still feminine in appearance. Strong firm topline which she held on the move and good depth throughout

2. Novis Szajani Ekko at Novapak, Lovely well balanced bitch with a nice head and

expression. Good true front with plenty of depth and strong in body. Well ribbed back and good return of upper arm. Moved out well 3. Gottlieb Russetmantle Lilou

LB(14)(3) 1. Aynsleys Vizash Heiress of Caorunn JW Balanced and well constructed girl. Elegant head with good proportions. Appealed for breed type to me. So well balanced with a straight front and enough depth. Stands on good feet and rear angulation not overdone. Moved very

Together 2. Elliott Vizslanya Pafrany for Zinniviz JW, built on finer lines than 1 but a lovely feminine girl with a nice head and contrasting eye. Arched reach of neck into a good shoulder placement. Tail set correct and moved out well with good extension. 3. Challis Vizslanya Vizi JW

Ob(8)(1) 1. Donurie's Russian Roulette(AI) Smart looking girl with a lovely breed type head & a slightly naughty look about her. She flowed very nicely from her head to her tail. Good spring of rib and moderate tuck up. Strong rear quarters which she used on the move. Handled well

2. Coombe's Amarantos Bellaria at Castlefield, Another impressive girl with a balanced feminine head. Nicely developed chest to elbows and a good brisket. Nothing overdone with good angles fore and aft 3. Gottlieb's Russetmantle Maia (AI)

CB (3) 1. Harpers SH. CH Pitswarren Jiko JW, another that I have admired since a puppy and she did not disappoint when I went over her. Upto size girl but everything is in proportion. She has strength all through but remains elegant and very eye-catching especially on the stack. Nice head

With moderate stop. Correct eye shape and a very alert expression. She has good length and moved well RCC 2. Carters SH>CH. Facanvadasz Banu JW, another worthy champion with a good head and moderate stop. Plenty of substance and bone but again remains feminine. Liked her infill

To brisket and depth. Moved on a nice easy ground covering stride. Nails could be shorter 3. Ward's SH.CH. Danton Obsession with Tantaraviz ShCEX

FTB(1) 1. Wall's CH Piroseg Mandarin of Perllanside JW, Well made girl all through and certainly looks like she could still do a days work at 8 years old. She has lovely soulful eyes which contrast with her bit of sugar facing. Well off for bone and substance. Plenty of heart room. Moved well

with purpose

SWB(3) Swallow's Facanvadasz Csilar of Csillogo 2. Steeden Lindenwood Hocus Pocus. Kind feminine head with a lovely ear set and expression. Elbows close to body and moderate tuck up. Good upper arm length and shoulder. Strength in quarters and moved well

3. GRIGONYTE Lt.CH Nadorpusztai Fuvola Luna (imp Hung)

VB (4) 1. Aynsleys SH.CH. Recuerdo Monika Of Caorunn JW, a quality 9 year old girl with a lovely head which is balanced and refined. Well made front assembly and standing on neat feet. She moved out very well with good extension and looked like she was enjoying her day BVIS

2. Hardcastle & Bradley SH.CH Vizslanya Szienna JW ShCEXOSW VW, another lovely breed type girl of 8 years with a lovely dark soft eye and attractive head, slightly arched neck into a good shoulder. Balanced body proportions and good depth. She moved freely with good reach

3. Clubb & Mason Orozhaza Lucy Lockett

BRACE (3) 1. Warner Nordickfield Dawn Run , these two looked a picture together and were so well matched and moved in tune with one another 2. Wall's Perllanside Fly the Flag, another well matched pair of Vizslas who moved in harmony together 3.
