The Taschler Trophy	"Chalice" Type Large Cup Presented by the late Mrs H Maniurka	Highest Score - Gundog Working Points Only
The Victoria Salver	Round Silver Salver Presented by Mr & Mrs Farquhar	Highest score - Gundog working and show Points, in the proportion of not more than one third to two thirds
The Gemini Trophy	Coloured model Vizsla on Stand Presented by Kay Norman	Runner Up to the Mabel Deakin Trophy Winner
The Barbera Douglas-Redding Memorial Trophy	Cut Glass Rose bowl on dark wood Donated by Sheila Gray	Show Points Only
The Craigan Memorial Award	Silver Vizsla depicted in Shetland Stone Donated by the Estate of the late Alec Macrae	Working Points Only collected by a Dog up to the age of three, and submitted by the 28th of February after the dogs third birthday
The Daisy Award* (New Award for 2020)	Donated by Jill & Geoff Charman	Novice Handler, competing in their 1 <sup>st</sup> season, achieving a CoM or place in a Field Trial
